NWEA/Acadience Formative and summative assessments are given throughout the year and results are used to drive instruction, develop learning plans, and make school-wide educational decisions.

Teaching and learning is designed to ensure students are becoming proficient by advancing on demonstrated mastery and encourage self-motivated and self-directed learning.
