Charter School: **Wallace Stegner Academy- West Valley Campus (Satellite)**

Action: **Readiness to open for fall 2021.**

Context of the School: Wallace Stegner Academy (WSA) was approved to open a satellite campus in January 2020, to operate in West Valley City, within the Granite School District Boundaries. The first school year will be 2021-2022.

The mission of school is:

WSA strives to foster a community of active learners through academic rigor and citizenship by providing an opportunity for at-risk students to close the achievement gap and achieve academic excellence through: academic rigor; direct instruction; data-driven instruction; ability-based mathematics, language arts, and reading classes; positive learning environments; and character development.

Satellite school serves grades K-8, with a maximum enrollment of 810.
