



Material Change to Charter: Canyon Grove Academy

Background

CGA offers a “hybrid” program targeted to families who want more choice and flexibility in their child’s education and more control over that education. It is designed to bridge the gap between homeschool and more traditional public schools.

This type of program has not shown positive academics, which is why they cannot be considered under the Covid Distance Pilot. CGA performs on par with other schools with a similar type of program.

Nevertheless, this type of program has a very healthy market demand, including at CGA. Since implementing this program, CGA has been able to grow their enrollment and the school is currently at capacity.





Request

The new Agreement will include provisions to run a distance program, and other material changes to their educational program. These changes represent major departures from the original Charter Agreement. However, CGA has been implementing these elements and program for quite some time.

If not approved, CGA would need to make major changes to current practice.
