Small Expansion Policy

It is the intent of the State Charter School Board (SCSB) to establish processes to meet the duties and obligations that have been placed on it as an authorizer pursuant to §53G-5-101 et seq. and to address such other matters that are deemed necessary to promote the purpose of the charter schools that it has authorized.

A small expansion request is defined in R277-552-2(4), and is considered a small expansion request if the expansion request:

- (a) Is for 50 or fewer students;
- (b) Would not necessitate a significant renovation; and
- (c) Is for no more than one additional grade.

A charter school authorized by the SCSB may apply for a small expansion request following the timeline established by the SCSB.
